Light, versatile and directional. A great all mountain ski. The underfoot and enhanced rocker allows for more float in powder if needed. Tailored towards powder skiing, but can still handle groomers. A fan favorite of the demo program.

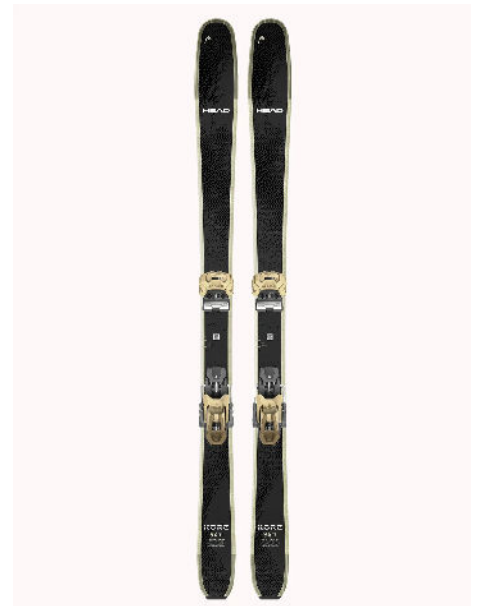

Head Kore 94

Redesigned from last year's Kore 93, the new and improved Kore offers excellent control turning on anything including groomers. The long radius of the ski keeps it stable at high speeds and the construction of the ski allows for quick, controlled turns while retaining a forgiving personality. The early rise rocker and a camber underfoot provide a smooth ride even in deep powder.

A freeride ski designed for resort skiing. 92 underfoot, the Rossignol “Airtip” tech concentrating weight underfoot and progressive rocker in the tips with rectangular sidewall construction gives this ski a perfect combo of performance and fun, floaty feel.

Atomic Maverick 88 Ti

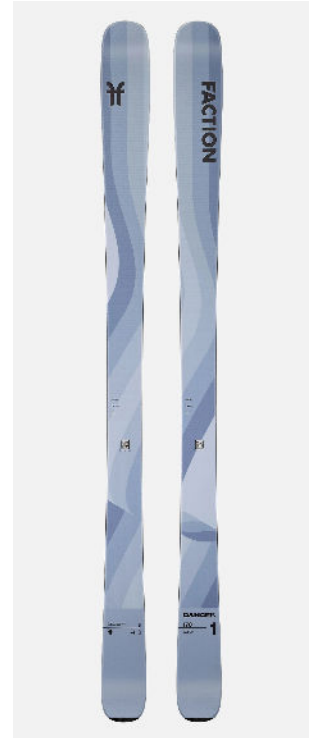


Faction Dancer 1
